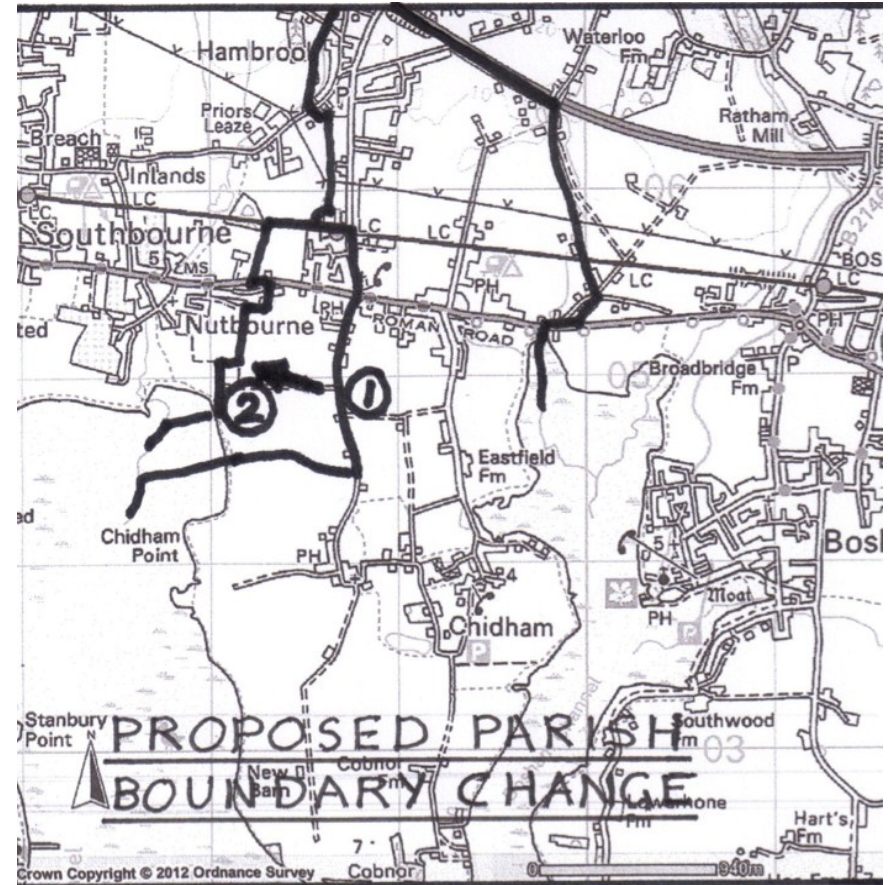
Meetings are held at 7.30 pm on the first Thursday in each month in Chidham & Hambrook Village Hall.

WHAT CHANGE IS PROPOSED?

- > At present, Nutbourne lies in the area that comes under Southbourne Parish Council.
- > **The District Council will ask you quite soon whether you would prefer Chidham & Hambrook Parish Council to look after your local interests.**

WHY CHANGE?

- Over the years, many people living in your area have asked for a change such that they would be in **Chidham & Hambrook Parish**, rather than in Southbourne Parish.
- A quick look at the Map on the front page shows just how strange the current Parish Boundary (1) is.
- The proposal is to move the Parish Boundary to the much more sensible position (2).
- Instead of your home being at the very eastern end of Southbourne Parish, you would be living at the heart of **Chidham & Hambrook Parish**.
- Chidham & Hambrook Parish Council actively initiates and supports local projects. You can be sure that we would serve you well.

CHANGE TO CHIDHAM AND HAMBROOK

SOME DETAILS

- ⇒ The proposed new boundary (see Boundary (2) in the map on the front page) follows national guidance.
- ⇒ The proposed Boundary runs along public footpaths, roads, the railway line and well-established hedges and ditches.
- ⇒ It also keeps at least a field's width away from housing development to provide some protection for residents from unwelcome new development next to existing housing .
- ⇒ Part of the Chidham peninsula is at present in Southbourne Parish! The proposed Boundary change would correct this.
